#### Question 1:

#### Answer:

The other things which Peelu could have brought for Lalu are a ripened papaya, bananas, or a jackfruit.

### Question 1:

Lalu loves red things. Peelu loves yellow things. The colour red is called 'lal' in Hindi and yellow is called 'peela'. What do you call these colours in your language?

### Answer:

In my language, Tamil, the colour red is called 'Civappu' (Ci-va-pu) & the colour yellow is called 'Mancal' (Man-jal)
